Final Report of Project for DV Protection in Multicultural Families

- 1. In the beginning state, there were many difficulties from H1N1 in organizing collective education and counseling. Therefore, instead of group gathering, we focused on direct contacts with multicultural couples, families and children for DV protection.
- 2. We could provide swift services for counseling and DV protection and also care services through the education of instructors who visit multicultural families twice per week (two hours).

Survey and Evaluation of Domestic Violence in Multicultural Families

- 1. According to Geumsan Police Station, there was no single report on domestic violence in Multicultural families during 2007–2008. In the 20th of October, 2009, eleven cases are reported without being further developed into criminal cases.
- 2. Although there were no criminal cases of domestic violence in multicultural families, DV is existing within many multicultural families to some extent.
- 3. Most of multicultural families are making relatively happy married life overcoming hardship and difficult stages.
- 4. A few multicultural families are in trouble due to DV, although they were not developed into criminal cases.
